



# Raging Grannies unConvention 2018

August 2 - 5, 2018 in Rochester, New York

Our theme: *Wherever women gather, failure is impossible.*

**What:** The unConvention is an opportunity for Raging Grannies to learn, share, and reinvigorate ourselves as we continue to advocate for social justice. We aspire to hold an UnConvention once every two years.

**When:** The 2018 Raging Granny unConvention will begin on Thursday, August 2 (check in to the hotel after 3 pm EDT) and conclude on Sunday, August 5 (depart by noon.)

**Where:** The 2018 unConvention will be held in Rochester, New York, former home of many activists including Susan B. Anthony and Frederick Douglass. The unConvention will take place at the Holiday Inn Rochester Downtown overlooking the Genesee River with a side trip to historic Seneca Falls. Book your flight into the Rochester International Airport (ROC) or take a train to the Amtrak station.

The cost per person for a shared room for a total of three nights is \$169.29 US; this special room rate is only available if you reserve by July 1. If you don't have a roommate but would like to take advantage of the shared room rate, please circle the appropriate box on the Registration Form.

# 2018 Raging Granny unConvention Details

## Primary Venue

Our primary venue is the [Holiday Inn Rochester Downtown](#) at 70 State Street in Rochester, NY. The hotel overlooks the Genesee River. Most of our meetings, meals, and activities will take place in the hotel's meeting rooms, making for a convenient and comfortable stay. The guest rooms at the Holiday Inn are spacious, quiet, and recently renovated. There is a heated outdoor pool, a fitness center, and free wi-fi. A free shuttle bus to and from the airport and train station is available.

## Fees

The unConvention Registration Fee of \$265 (U.S. or Canadian) covers all meals from Thursday night through Sunday morning, transportation to activities and the Grand Rage, meeting room fees, and general unConvention expenses. You will need to make a reservation to stay at the hotel which will cost an additional \$169.29 U.S. for three nights in a shared room. If you drive a car, there will be a \$4/day parking fee.

## Schedule

Expect plenty of time to network with and learn from other grannies, which is, after all, one of the reasons we like to get together. On two evenings, gaggles will have a chance to share highlights of their gaggle's activities with the entire group. We plan time for exploration, relaxation, learning, reflection and of course, lots of laughter.
